Other products included in the contract are ABIS System, Facelt(R) Argus Facial Screening, Facelt technology, single fingerprint readers, and FaceExaminer, a revolutionary, forensic application unique to L-1 Identity Solutions that helps to analyze, search and identify faces of wanted subjects taken from surveillance video where image quality is typically poor and subjects may not be directly facing the camera.
